Question 1: What information will the counselor look for in Jadine's Student Report? (Select all that apply)

1. Composite score, INDICATED (+2): The Composite score ranges from 1 to 36. Jadine's Composite score is 21. The Student Report provides the approximate percentage of recent high school graduates in the U.S. and in Jadine's state who took the ACT and received scores that are the same as or lower than Jadine's. The Composite score is Jadine's average score of the four subject areas. The Composite score should be interpreted with a standard error of 1 point.
2. Subscale scores, INDICATED (+2): The subscale scores range from 1 to 18 and reflect Jadine's knowledge in English (24), mathematics (19), reading (23), and science (18). Percentages can be interpreted to help Jadine better understand how she performed compared to other recent high school graduates in her state who took the ACT. Subscale scores should be interpreted using a range based on a standard error of measure of 2 points.
5. Benchmark scores, INDICATED (+1): ACT provides benchmark scores for the four subject areas. The benchmark score indicates Jadine's chances of getting a B or C in the related coursework at the college level. If the score is marked with an asterisk (*), then there is a 50% likelihood that Jadine will earn a B or higher or about a 75% likelihood she will earn a C or higher in a related first-year college course.
6. College reports, INDICATED (+1): The ACT also provides College Reports for all the schools Jadine indicated as her first four college choices when she registered for the ACT. The Student Report provides admission related information and will allow Jadine to compare her performance with others who have been accepted at the colleges she indicated.

Question 2: Which of the following would be accurate statements for the counselor to share with Jadine about her ACT Student Report? (Select all that apply)

3. Jadine would do well in her first year English and reading. INDICATED (+2): Jadine has a 50% chance of earning a B or higher, or about a 75% chance of earning a C or higher in first year college courses related to English and reading.
4. Jadine's Writing score indicates writing to be a strength. INDICATED (+2): Jadine scored exceptionally well in the Writing portion of the ACT. Her essay demonstrated evaluation skills, solid support for her points, varied sentence structure, and well selected wording.
