

## Initial Post Instructions

This discussion has two parts.

- 1. Read the following in your textbook: “Unhappy Birthday” by Marlo Morgan (pp. 153-154) and “Bringing out the Flirt in You” by Christine Ng (pp. 155-157). In complete sentences and with depth and detail, answer the following:**

- *As process analysis pieces, how are these two works different in purpose and scope? In other words, are they small-task-related, describing a larger, more timely process, or entertaining/informative?*

Both writings are describing a larger context of cultures and tradition. They both talk about the bigger picture, how Morgan described the people of Aborigine recognizing someone by a special party, but it has nothing to do with age or birthdate, it is in recognition of uniqueness and contribution to life (Russell, 2016, pp. 153-154), and Ng suggests to enjoy the natural pleasures of flirting, and more than anything else, allow your natural confidence and personality to shine through (Russell, 2016, pp. 155-157)
