The Lewis and Clark Expedition

For ages, people in Europe and the United States have believed that a way exists that will open the Pacific to American influence and commerce (Corbett et al., 2017). President Thomas Jefferson was one of many persons who shared this goal when he bought the Louisiana Territory from France in April of that year. Jefferson requested a detailed analysis of western resources and topography, as well as strong ties with indigenous peoples, from Meriwether Lewis and William Clark in order to weaken British control of the Indian fur trade. Expeditions like this one are deemed successful because they uncover previously unknown facts about North American ecosystems, geological formations, and social structures (History.com editors, 2020).
