

Module 2 Guidelines Part 3 (Graded)

(1 pt) A 10-year-old patient has a bad cough and high fever. The mother found out her child had spent the night at a friend's house who recently tested positive for COVID-19. The mother is concerned as her child did not receive the COVID-19 vaccine. What information would the coder capture?

- cough, fever, COVID-19, undervaccination status
- cough, fever, COVID-19, COVID-19 exposure, undervaccination status
- cough, fever, COVID-19 exposure, undervaccination status
- COVID-19

Correct

(1 pt) Can the coder apply U07.1 for COVID-19?



No, there is not a positive lab test indicating COVID-19 in the last 24 hours since tests older than 24 hours are not valid.



No, there is not a confirmed diagnosis by the provider.

Correct

Guideline I.C.1.g.1.a indicates code only confirmed cases as documented by the provider or documentation of a positive test.



Yes, the patient was around someone with COVID-19 and has the same signs/symptoms.



Yes, the patient has COVID-19.

(1 pt) Which **subterm** of COVID-19 would the coder reference in the ICD10CM alphabetic index to find the proper diagnosis code for the child's exposure? (use one **lowercase** word only)

Correct answer 1 -

Correct

Coders reference "contact (with)" with a notation to *see also* "exposure (to)". Either term *contact* or *exposure* will produce a code for COVID-19.
