

Module 6 Application Test

This question has been re-worded from what appears on the screen. Use this question:

A 7-year-old patient is seen in the OR to have a procedure of a secondary palatoplasty. The patient's assessment is unilateral cleft palate. What ICD-10-CM code is reported?

Correct answer 1 - Q35.9

An 8-year-old male patient is brought to the ED where he begins to seize. The ED physician quickly stabilized the patient. What ICD-10-CM code is reported for the seizure?

Correct answer 1 - R56.9

Office note: "This 3-year-old was brought to the office by her mother, who reports that the child has been pulling on her left ear and saying 'It hurts.' Examination of the ears shows that there are no findings in the right ear; however, there is a foreign object in the left ear."

This encounter would be reported with the 7-digit ICD-10-CM code _____.

This initial encounter for a foreign object in the left ear would be reported with the 7-digit ICD-10-CM code .

Correct answer 1 - T16.2XXA

A patient mistook their heart medicine for their antibiotic medicine. The patient was treated in the ED. Which drug toxicity classification would the coder assign? (Review the definitions found in the guidelines if you need guidance.)

 - toxic effect
 - adverse effect
 - poisoning

A chromosomal abnormality is *always* listed as the principal or first-listed diagnosis.

- False, a chromosomal abnormality may be first-listed/principal or secondary.
