Correct answer 1 - T38.816A

Jane was bit by a rattlesnake at the adventure park. Which term that provides a diagnosis code could a coder reference in the alphabetic index for this scenario? (HINT: This term will have a CODE next to it - NOT a "see" or "see also" note.)
