Nursing Care Delivery

Patient Centered Care:

- Adapting care as the needs of an individual change.
- Taking time to assure the person understands new information about their health.
- Conveying respect for the individual's health and lifestyle choices.

Total Patient Care:

- RN responsible for all care in a shift.
- Requires a high degree of interprofessional collaboration.
- Frequently used to care for critically ill patients.

Case Management:

- Links health services across all level of care.
- Clinicians focus on groups of patients with specific illnesses.
- Goal is to improve outcomes while reducing overall cost of care.
