-best tool for establishing a psychiatric diagnosis

-combination of observations, impressions, & interpretation of client responses

- appearance
- behavior
- speech
- affect
- thought process
- thought content
- cognition

mental health

"a state of well-being in which every individual realizes his or her own potential, can cope with normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to make a contribution to her or his community"

mental status

-refers to emotional (feeling) and cognitive (knowing) function -functioning is inferred through assessment of an individual's behaviors:

- consciousness
- language
- mood and affect
- orientation
- attention
- memory
- abstract reasoning
- thought process
- thought content
- perceptions
