ANSWER: B. SUDAFED. Sudafed is a sympathomimetic associated with abuse and resulted in Congress passing a law to limit the amount purchased at one time. Sudafed is a brand name of pseudoephedrine; it can easily be converted to methamphetamine, a widely used drug of abuse.
