

Renata Chapman 42-year-old female

HPI

Chief complaint of two breast lumps. {onset}. Pain is in the back of the throat and constant {location and duration}. Also, come to fever of 101 degrees Fahrenheit with chills last night, and swollen neck glands {characteristics}. Aggravating factors include eating sharp foods like chips. Relieving factors include drinking warm tea with lemon and ibuprofen with fair relief. Treatments include ibuprofen 800 MG twice daily. Pain level is 6/10 {severity}.

Problem Statement

Renata Chapman 42-year-old female, presenting for complaint of 2 right breast lumps. She 1st noticed the lumps about 6 months ago while taking a shower. Positive for 11 lb weight loss over last 3 months. Negative for nausea, vomiting, abdominal or breast pain, breast discharge, scaly nipples, pain, swelling, or redness. Physical exam reveals 1st a 2.5 cm mass palpable in upper-inner quadrant at 2 o'clock position, 2nd a 2.0 cm, lesion to right breast is palpable at 12 o'clock position. A right axillary lymph node noted that is firm and mobile. The lesions are negative for skin fixation, inflammation, or erythema. Negative for abdominal distention or tenderness. She had an abnormal screening mammogram 3 years ago of right breast. Stereotactic breast biopsy results revealed Atypical ductal hyperplasia. Recommended Genetic testing, follow-up and repeat mammo in 6 months, no record of completion.

Review of systems

a review/inventory of body systems of patient symptoms subjective only includes positives or reports and negatives or denies.

General: Positive for 11 lb weight loss over last 3 months. Denies fever, weight gain, weakness, fatigue, changes in appetite.

HEENT/NECK: Head- trauma or tenderness. Eyes-denies changes in vision eye redness or drainage. Ears-denies pain or drainage. Nose- denies congestion, rhinorrhea, sinus pain. Throat-report sore throat denies hoarseness and mouth sores. Neck- denies stiffness, pain, swollen glands, or limited ROM.

Cardiovascular: Denies chest pain, discomfort, or pressure; dizziness, palpitations, decreased exercise tolerance, blue/cold fingers or toes.
