2. Knowledge

- **Awareness and understanding** of a set of information and ways that information can be made useful to support a specific task or arrive at a decision. This knowledge building is an ongoing process engaged in while a person is conscious and going about his or her normal daily activities.

- **Knowledge applied in a practical way or translated into actions;** the use of knowledge and experience to heighten common sense and insight so as to exercise sound judgment in practical matters. Sometimes thought of as **the highest form of common sense**, resulting from accumulated knowledge or erudition (deep, thorough learning) or enlightenment (education that results in understanding and the dissemination of knowledge). Wisdom is **the ability to apply valuable and viable knowledge, experience, understanding, and insight while being prudent and sensible.** It is
