Explain the role of the community health nurse in partnership with community stakeholders for population health promotion. Explain why it is important to appraise community resources (nonprofit, spiritual/religious, etc.) as part of a community assessment and why these resources are important in population health promotion.

Answer;

"Community health nursing involves health promotion of individuals and families, providing care in settings such as occupational or educational systems and Public health nursing addresses health promotion beyond an individual's or family's needs, incorporating community aspects and global or environmental concerns", Green, S. Z. (2018).

According to Green, S. Z. (2018), the public health nursing role involves advocating for the health of populations, establish credibility with the community, concentrate on an aggregate or groups to improve the health of all, seek prevention of illness, acts as a role model for leadership in provisions of health, fosters community organization, incorporates epidemiologic knowledge and methods, conduct health assessment for entire populations for prevalence of disease, risk factors, self-perceived health status, functional ability, and psychological stressors, demonstrates versatility in dynamic collaborative environments, exhibit cultural competence with diverse populations, design interventions for specific populations and evaluate outcomes of interventions.

Public Health Nurses practice at the "organizational, community, and public policy levels as well and
